Tourist Tidbits: Colonial Period Styles

The architectural styles of the different colonial powers are used in many buildings built between 1511 and 1957. Located in Melaka Town, the Stadthuys with its heavy wooden doors, thick red walls and wrought-iron hinges is the most imposing relic of the Dutch period in Melaka. It is a fine example of Dutch masonry and woodworking skills. Built between 1641 and 1660 it is believed to be the oldest building in the East. [More](#)
